

RESOLUTION NO. 45-2018

RESOLUTION REGARDING THE APPOINTMENT OF A STUDY COMMITTEE TO  
EVALUATE THE FORM OF GOVERNMENT IN WEBER COUNTY

**WHEREAS**, it has been approximately 20 years since the form of government has been officially evaluated by a study committee in Weber County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Weber County Commission ("Commission") finds it appropriate to periodically evaluate and study the various forms of government available for citizens to choose from in the administration of local government; and


**WHEREAS**, Utah Code Ann. § 17-52a-302 provides that a county legislative body may initiate this process by passing a resolution to submit to the voters a ballot question to determine whether a study committee should be appointed to consider and possibly recommend a change in the form of government in Weber County;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Commission directs the Weber County Clerk/Auditor to place the following question on the November 5th, 2019, ballot, which is currently the next special election scheduled pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 20A-1-204:


"Shall a study committee be appointed to consider and possibly recommend a change in Weber County's form of government?"
